Boat Diver Course

Boat diving eliminates long surface swims, increases availability of dive sites, and generally makes for easier diving. Develop your knowledge of proper boat etiquette, personal conduct, and basic boat terminology by enrolling in the **PADI Boat Diver Specialty** course. Participants learn how to plan, organize, and conduct safe dives from a boat while obtaining guided experiences with boat diving entries/exits and use of emergency safety equipment.
