

PADI Wreck Diver

PADI Adventure Diver (or equivalent diver certification)
Minimum age of 15 years old

Students must supply:

Mask, Fins, Booties, and Snorkel
Safety Signal Tube and Whistle
Logbook
Underwater watch and RDP or dive computer
Dive Knife
Slate with Pencil
Reel
Primary and secondary dive light
